Mission Possible ...

God is at work in the world, and He wants you to join Him. This assignment is called your mission, and it is different from your ministry. Your ministry is your service to believers in the Body of Christ, while your mission is your service to unbelievers in the world. God created you for both.

Your life mission is both shared and specific. One part of it is a responsibility you share with every other Christian, and the other part is an assignment that is unique to you. The word "Apostelos" comes from the Greek word means "sending." Being a Christian includes being sent into the world as a representative of Jesus Christ. Jesus said, "As the Father has sent me, I am sending you."

The disciples were sent to proclaim a message. Jesus entrusted them with spreading the Good News. Jesus reveals three requirements for the disciples to be able to fulfill this command.

1. They need to know the message and the source of the message (John 17:6): The first requirement for preaching the Good News was that the disciples needed to know what the Gospel is and where it has come from. Jesus, speaking about the disciples said this to the Father: "For I gave them the words you gave me and they accepted them" (Jn 17:8) and "I have revealed you to those whom you gave me" (Jn 17:6) but we can't preach a Gospel until we know what it is and where it has come from. The disciples spent three years around Jesus listening to his message. It was an intense time. Today we have to know more about Jesus through Holy Spirit and called to simply preach what Jesus has revealed to us.

2. They need to be committed (John 17:6-8): The second requirement to be able to preach the Good News is that the disciples needed to be committed. In other words they needed to be real DISCIPLES.

3. They need to be faithful (John 17:15-17): The third requirement to preach the Good News is they need to be faithful and so Jesus prays for them to be protected from evil. The Lord taught his disciples to be aware of evil and pray for protection from it. "Deliver us from evil." (Mt 6:13) Jesus praying to His father, My prayer is not that you take them out of the world, but that you protect them from the evil one" (Jn 17:15)

In conclusion, the challenge of the Great Commission we need to...

1. Know the message and where it has come from.
2. Be committed to following Christ ourselves and
3. Pray for protection from evil that we too will not fall.

I thank all the people of God, who really spend time in praying for missionaries and mission field in India. We serve God who will fill our lives with rewards! Let' be a missionary in the army of God to win souls for His Kingdom.

Report of 2010 from FEBA: The program worked a transformation in the lives of the listeners. It gave a new turn to the lives of our listeners. Listener started upon a new way of life. 'Nade Nudi' programs seeks the listeners to enter into the new life of spiritual aspiration, purity and devotion then the Christ-spirit must take its birth within the heart. This is the real Christmas when the Divine element begins to express itself in the heart of the man. From then onward, light begins to shine where darkness was before. Ignorance gives place to the beginning of wisdom. Impurity is replaced by purity. Hatred ceases and love begins to blossom forth. This is the message shared through 'Nade Nudi'.

Now, here is the testimony of NP. NP is a non-Christian, he happens to listen to our 'Nade Nudi' programs through All India Radio regularly. The Spirit of God convicted him through our programs. Jayamma from Mysore was convinced through our 'Nade Nudi' program that Jesus came to this World not for Christians alone but for all humankind. She also started to taste the Lord in her life and is eager to know Him more intimately.

South India Outreach



We are excited to share with you the passion and vision God has placed on our hearts for the people of South India. Our vision is to show Jesus every day in every way through pioneering churches, training leaders, and compassion ministries.

South Indian Outreach operates two schools which bring education to those who otherwise may receive none. Tilaknagar and Kumbarkoppal Grace Schools combined have over 800 students who come from India's low income families. India does not have enough government-run schools. In such a situation the opportunity for extending hope through education is vast.

Presently Karnataka Congregation supporting one student from Grace School:

Here is the picture of the student you requested for our Grace Schools Scholarship Program. Spoorthi is a current resident of our Open Arms Crisis Center. Her father abandoned her and her mother, and her mother is working a night-shift job to support not only herself and Spoorthi but also her ill mother. As she was unable to manage on her own we agreed to take in Spoorthi for a year and help them get back on their feet.



Yearly Report of Spoorthi: She is physically doing well. She was sick three weeks back due to an infection but is doing much better now and is quite active. She continues to make friends and is a well minded student in school. She is actively growing in her faith through daily devotionals and also children's church.

Her mother comes and visits her each week. We are working on trying to get her mother come live her with us in the center so she can have a relationship that is healthy and fulfilling. Her mother works at an Ashram a little away from us. We are trying to provide her with the counseling needed to become debt free and also be self-sufficient.
