Around the world, there are so many people looking for freedom. Freedom in relationships, jobs, finance, entertainment etc... The truth is, real freedom is difficult to find. Around us we see advertisements like "buy one and get one free", "be free to express", "freedom is our choice" etc. No one likes the word 'why' as it always restricts the concept of 'freedom'.

Bible speaks about freedom in connection with Jesus. Real freedom can be found in Christ. 'If the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.' John 8:36. Today many confused and do not know what they are looking for. Most of the time, when we say freedom, we always think, free to do anything with no boundary / limit to it.

True liberty is to exercise self-control, which is the fruit of the spirit that we can freely receive. The fact is, we are free to make good or bad choices. There are countless ways you and I hinder our freedom. For example by giving into the reactions of our flesh - responding to painful situation with unforgiveness and holding on to the hurts leads us into the bondage of bitterness, depression and anger. But if we bring out hurts and pain to God, he can make all things work together for our good. I know it's hard to make right choices. But

I also know from personal experience that God's grace is available in abundance to help us to make the right choice every time.

I am free to eat sweets, but I will choose not to eat much because it is not good for health. Free to spend money but not to get into the debt or free to talk but not to gossip about others. No matter who you are, once flesh rules in you, it knows only one word '**MORE**'. As desires increase so do our wants. For example, food, cloth, money, sex – the more you have the greater your desire.

The fact is, we are free to make good or bad choices.

If you make a decision to obey God's grace enables you to do His word. Obeying God is the basic foundation of happiness.

Obeying his word means learning and walking according to the Word of God. For example when we make a mistake, we have to admit it, repent and ask God to forgive us. Then we need to receive his grace to change us. Hebrew 4:14 and to be firm in walking with him and ask God to



do what we can't. As you and I choose to make one right decision after another, we'll keep moving forward and stay free from bondages. Obedience to God's word will keep us safe reaping the blessings of joy and peace.

Once we're determined that we'll do whatever it makes to be free, nothing can keep us in bondage. When you and I make right choices, God's grace hooks up with us and enables us to carry on. 1 Peter 2:16 God' has given the freedom to become more like Christ or to grow in the image of Christ. Don't Pray...Be cool?

Greetings to You Beloved People of God,

Why should I NOT pray?

#1 - God knows everything, then why should I pray?

If I can inform God-something about our problems, needs, worries ...then it will make sense to pray. But God is omnipotent, he knows everything... then why should I pray? My prayer doesn't do anything, he knows everything.

#2 - God is able to do anything, ...he is not only omniscient but also omnipotent. He is powerful, he will do whatever he wants to do. So our prayer is not necessary, because he knows what to do or what not do.

#3 - God controls everything; everything is in God's hand (Ps.24: 1) What is the need or why should I pray Nothing is going to happen or change because He controls everything... He will do it the way He likes it....is it not?

#4 - God predetermined everything. God is a wise God, He does not have after thoughts, he does not plan as he goes. He is a fantastic, all knowing God who is well planned. He knows his purpose and is very clear about what he wants, and is determined about it. **Pre-determined** – means it has already been decided. If He is going to do what he has already planned, then why should I pray. God does not change, He is unchangeable. if I cannot change his heart, then why should I pray?

Yes ...why should I pray?

I. Prayer is working with God

Prayer is not just begging God do this or that for us. Prayer is joining hands with God or working with God. God has not only great purposes and plans for us but also he has great plans and purpose for the whole mankind...so we are working with him.

Prayer is like a Board Meeting sitting with Him together and talking about what must be done, how it could be done, and how to go about it. So prayer is not man's begging God... 'Prayer' is man partnering and working with God..

II. In Prayer, we rule and exercise dominion

God said 'let them rule' ... We can rule through our prayers. How do we rule and exercise authority. The Centurion said 'if I tell some one to go and he goes....'. That is authority. In the same way, we can exercise authority through prayer.

Today, if we are cool about prayer, not seeking Him or exercising his authority, we will be like a man who had single talent, but was fearful to use or invest it and buried it in the ground. Many believers have similarly hidden the talent of 'prayer' underground without ever using it.

Prayer is a SIM CARD, we have to insert into our Handset (Heart), search for signal to speak with Our Heavenly Father. Jesus is the only way to get connected with God. My dear beloved people of God, how about your life... lukewarm or cool? If it is, then...you are a big fool. Devil is trying to make you a fool; don't be one. Instead kneel down & PRAY, Jesus will send His Spirit to start a FIRE in your spiritual life.

ಶುದ್ಧವಾದ ಹೃದಯ ಕೀರ್ತನೆ 51 10-13, ಭಕ್ತನಾದ ದಾವೀದನು ಹೀಗೆ ಹೇಳುತ್ತಾನೆ. ದೇವರೆ ನನ್ನಲ್ಲಿ ಶುದ್ಧ ಹೃದಯವನ್ನು ನಿರ್ಮಿಸು. ನನಗೆ ಸ್ಥಿರ ಚಿತ್ತವನ್ನು ಅನುಗ್ರಹಿಸಿ ನನ್ನನ್ನು ನೂತನ ಪಡಿಸು. ನಮ್ಮ ಹೃದಯ ಪ್ರಾರ್ಥನೆಯ ಹೃದಯವಾಗಿರಬೇಕಾದರೆ ದೇವರು ನಮ್ಮಲ್ಲಿ ಶುದ್ಧ ಹೃದಯವನ್ನು ನಿರ್ಮಿಸಬೇಕು.

ಪೂರ್ಣ ಹೃದಯ ಧರ್ಮೋಪದೇಶಕಾಂಡ 4 29 ರಲ್ಲಿ, ಮೋಶೆ ಇಸ್ರಾಯೇಲರಿಗೆ ಹೀಗೆ ಹೇಳುತ್ತಾನೆ. ನೀವು ಸಂಪೂರ್ಣವಾಗಿ ಹೃದಯದಿಂದಲೂ, ಮನಸ್ಸಿನಿಂದಲೂ ನಿಮ್ಮ ದೇವರನ್ನು ಹುಡುಕಿದರೆ ಆತನು ನಿಮಗೆ ಸಿಕ್ಕುವನು. ನಾವು ಕೇವಲ ಬಾಯಿಯಿಂದ ಇಲ್ಲವೆ ಬುದ್ಧಿಯಿಂದ ಮಾತ್ರ ಪ್ರಾರ್ಥಿಸಿದರೆ ಸಾಲದು ; ಪೂರ್ಣ ಹೃದಯ ಇಲ್ಲವೆ ಆತ್ಮದಿಂದಲೂ ಪ್ರಾರ್ಥಿಸುವವರಾಗಬೇಕು. ಅದೇ ದೇವರನ್ನು ಹುಡುಕಿಕಂಡು ಕೊಳ್ಳುವ ಅನುಭವ.

ಈ ಮೂರು ಅಂಶಗಳು ನಮ್ಮ ಹೃದಯದಲ್ಲಿ ಇಲ್ಲದೆ ನಾವು ಪ್ರಾರ್ಥಿಸಲು ಸಾಧ್ಯವಿಲ್ಲ. ಇಂತಹ ಒಂದು ಒಳ್ಳೆಯ ಸುಮಧುರವಾದ ಅನುಭವವನ್ನು ಪಡೆದು ಕೊಳ್ಳಲಿಕ್ಕಾಗಿ ತಂದೆಯಾದ ದೇವರಿಗೆ ವಿಧೇಯರಾಗಿ ಪವಿತ್ರಾತ್ಮ ಭರಿತರಾಗಿ ಪ್ರಾರ್ಥನೆಗೆ ಆದ್ಯತೆ ಕೊಟ್ಟು ಪ್ರಾರ್ಥನಾ ಹೃದಯವನ್ನು ಹೊಂದಿಕೊಂಡು ಪ್ರಾರ್ಥನಾ ವೀರರು. ಪ್ರಾರ್ಥನಾ ವೀರಾಂಗನೆಯರು ಆಗೋಣ.

Approach God Boldly with Your Needs

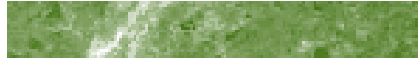
Our relationship with Lord must be so intimate that we can go to him daily, many times a day if necessary. I'm not speaking of the shallow, faithless dialogues we spoke earlier: God, if you'll help me pass this test, I'll study harder. No, I mean our prayers must be the result of a genuine faith in and understanding of God's power to bring change and answer to our needs. Our prayers must be sincere petitions to a personal God who passionately love us and has promised never to leave us or forsake us.

It is not enough to communicate with when we are in trouble. The prayers that bring results are those that flow naturally out of regular communication with the Savior, who is also our best friend, our comforter, and our source. When we maintain that kind of close spiritual union with the Lord, we can come boldly and unashamedly to Him with our needs, no matter how great or small they may be.

The words of Psalms 37:4&5 are a great encouragement to take our desires, needs, and problems to the Lord and expect an answer:

Delight yourself also in the lord, and he shall give you the desires of your heart.

Commit your way to the Lord, Trust in Him, And he shall bring it to act.
