Keeps On Cleansing You... By Ps. Shalom

Apart from the blood of Christ, you and I could not have a relationship with our heavenly Father. Jesus Sacrificial death made it possible for sinful man to approach Holy God. Because of His blood, believers are redeemed, forgiven, justified and sanctified and they have access to their Creator. That's why we call it the precious blood of Jesus.

The devil will always make you feel that you are not qualified or clean enough to go near God. But the truth is, regardless of how you feel and what you have done, the blood of Jesus Christ cleanses us from all sin.

During the day, the devil may whisper in your head, "You cannot go into God's presence because you have not been reading your Bible, prayed and serving in church." Or he will whisper that it is because of the sin which you have just committed.

But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin. *1 John 1:7 "Amen"* In the original Greek text, the tense for the word "cleanses" denotes a present continuous action. This means that once you are a believer, the blood of Jesus Christ keeps on cleansing you from every sin!

Every Child of God must know that you are always forgiven in this continuous "wash cycle" of Jesus' blood. Because you are continually cleansed, you are always in the light. You will fail here and there, but you are still in the light. You are not under guilt or condemnation because the blood is continuously washing you!

The Bible says that we overcome the devil, the accuser of our brethren, by the blood of the Lamb. (Revelation 12:11) If you have sinned, remind yourself that Jesus' blood keeps on cleansing you from every sin — 24 hours a day, seven days a week — and move on with God! The devil cannot defeat you when your faith is in the blood that cleanses you continuously.

Secondly, the Blood of Jesus is precious because of who He is. Today, You and I be forgiven not because of God is merciful but because Christ went to the Cross and shed His blood (Eph 1:7). Christ shed His blood in our place, the Father not only forgives our sin but also declares us righteous (Rom 5:17).

The Blood Of Jesus Protects –Ps. Joseph Prince

Exodus 12:13 ... And when I see the blood, I will pass over you; and the plague shall not be on you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt.

For 400 years, the children of Israel were slaves in Egypt. Life for them was one of hard labor, pain, loss and even death. When Moses their deliverer came, what soon followed was one plague after another on the Egyptians. But none of the plagues caused Pharaoh to release the Israelites until they put the blood on their doorposts. What nine plagues could not do, the blood did! The Israelites were finally set free because of the blood.

Are you under any kind of bondage? Are your loved ones held captive by the destroyer who is bent on destroying them? Plead the blood of the Lamb of God over all that is yours and your family's. When nothing else seems to work, His blood always works!

You see, when you plead the blood of Jesus, the destroyer cannot come near. When he sees the blood, he must respect the blood. He cannot touch what is covered by the blood. The blood of Jesus truly protects and sets you free!

The Blood Alone Saves Now the blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you are.

On the night of the first Passover, many of the children of Israel were probably anxious. Imagine one Israelite asking another nervously, "Did you hear that the angel of death is passing through tonight?" "Yes! We were told to put the blood of the lamb on the doorposts of our home and everything would be all right. Is that true?" Like the Israelites, you might be wondering, "Can the blood really protect me? How much blood do I have to put on my doorposts? Will the angel of death get me if I am fearful?"

Beloved Children, don't add to God's conditions. He said, "When I see the blood, I will pass over you and the plague shall not be on you to destroy you." He did not say, "When I see the blood, plus your understanding, efforts, obedience, faithfulness and refusal to give in to fear, then I will pass over you."

It is the blood of Jesus alone that delivers you. If you think that it is because of your faith, then you will

always be wondering, "Do I have enough faith?", it is His blood alone that saves. And when God sees that you see that it is the blood alone that saves, He calls that faith in the blood, and every plague will pass over you!

God wants you to know that it is Jesus' blood alone that saves because every time you think that your deliverance depends partly on God and partly on you, you will not have a settled peace in your heart. But when you know that it is the blood alone that saves, you will have an unshakable peace.

It was the blood that saved the children of Israel from the destroyer on that Passover night and it is still the blood that saves today. And all you need to do for the blood to avail is to say, "Father, I thank You that the blood of Jesus alone covers me and my family. No evil, plague or disaster will befall me or my family because of the blood!"

Five Reasons Why the Blood is Precious

Sin makes the blood of Jesus precious because only the blood of Jesus has the power to cleanse us of our sins. When we accept Jesus into our hearts, God looks at us through the blood Jesus shed. We are brought into right standing with Him, which is why we need not carry guilt and condemnation in our hearts.

When Adam and Eve disobeyed God, they turned their authority over to Satan, and he became their father. However, Jesus shed His blood so we could be children of God again. We were purchased with the precious blood of Jesus (1 Peter 1:18, 19) In order to have fellowship with God, we must be born again and have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

The Blood of Jesus is Our Stronghold - Ps. Crefflo Dollar

We are living in a very interesting time. Jesus' return is near, and as a result, the enemy is doing everything he can to steal, kill, and destroy as many people as possible. The spirit of fear is rampant in the world today, and those who do not have a relationship with the Lord are ruled by it. It should be no surprise that current events are pointing toward the culmination of the end of this age. Wars, rumors of wars, natural disasters, global economic downturns, and many other catastrophic events are not only on the horizon but are taking place now.

In the midst of all these things, our comfort can be found in Psalm 91, which promises divine protection and peace for those who trust in the Lord and continually abide in His presence. He is our stronghold in times of trouble. When Psalm 91:1 talks about the "secret place of the most high," it is actually talking about the blood of Jesus. When Christians stay under the covering of the blood of Jesus by faith, they are absolutely protected and safe for all time, and throughout eternity. Zechariah 9:11, 12 says, "As for thee also, by the blood of thy covenant I have sent forth thy prisoners out of the pit wherein is no water. Turn you to the strong hold, ye prisoners of hope: even today do I declare that I will render double unto thee." The blood of the new covenant, which is the blood of Jesus, is a stronghold that is a place of security and prosperity.

So how do we make God our refuge and habitation? We do this by declaring what the Word says about the blood and about the security that is found in His presence. When we say what we believe, we make what we believe a reality. Therefore, we must declare every day that we dwell in the secret place of the most High, and we are covered under the blood of Jesus. Daily confession of God's Word is what activates the divine protection of the Lord and releases angelic assistance.

"Nothing but the Blood of Jesus" by Collected

A song which emphasizes the fact that we have redemption only through the blood of Christ is "Nothing But The Blood of Jesus." It was first published in the 1876 Gospel Music which Lowry co-edited with William Howard Doane (1832-1915). Many songbooks have only three or four stanzas, but Lowry actually wrote six! The song reminds us how important the blood of Jesus Christ is to us.

Stanza 1 talks about its power to take away sin.: Every human being has to deal with the problem of sin (Romans 3:23). This sin needs to be washed away (Acts 22:16). Only the blood of Jesus can make us whole again (Mark 2:17).

Stanza 2 talks about its power to provide pardon: When we sin, we need pardon (Exodus 34:9). Not only do we need pardon, we need to see what can bring that pardon (Hebrews 2:9). And what we see is that only the blood of Jesus can cleanse us from sin (1 John 1:7).

Stanza 3 talks about its power to atone.: The blood of goats and calves cannot take away sin (Hebrews 10:4). Naught of good that we might do can atone for our sins (Titus 3:5). Yet, to take away sin, something is needed to atone for it, and it is the death of Christ by which He shed His blood for us (Romans 5:8-11).

Stanza 4 talks about its power to bring righteousness.: Because of what Jesus did for us we can have hope (Colossians 1:27). Because of what Jesus did for us we can have peace (Ephesians 2:14-17). And because of what Jesus did for us we can have righteousness (Philippians 3:9).


Stanza 5 talks about its power to help us overcome: God wants us to overcome (1 John 5:4). God wants us to reach our home (Colossians 1:5). And to make this possible, Jesus shed His blood for our redemption (Matthew 26:28).

Stanza 6 talks about its power to produce joy in our lives: We should give glory to the Lord (Revelation 1:6). We should sing to Him with thanks in our hearts (Ephesians 5:19, Colossians 3:16). And we should praise Him because He has washed our robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb (Revelation 7:9-14)."

The chorus helps us to understand the importance of Christ's blood to our salvation. Without the shedding of blood there is no remission of sin" (Hebrews 9:22).
