Promise Word for the Year...2013

If you experienced disappointing results or setbacks last year, don't dwell on them anymore. Expect to see good success this year. See yourself as the blessed man—the evergreen, ever-fruitful tree planted by the waters. This means that if you are a parent, expect to have more favor with your children. Expect to spend more quality time with them. Expect them to excel in their studies. And if you've been believing God for a child, expect to conceive this year. Begin to expect unceasing fruitfulness in every area of your life!

Jeremiah 17:7 tells us clearly that the blessed man is someone who trusts and hopes in the



Lord. So if you want to be the blessed man Jeremiah speaks of this year, start putting your trust and hope in the Lord.

God certainly doesn't want you to live life as the cursed man. He sent His Son Jesus to die on the cross for you and redeem you from every curse so that you can live an abundant life. Today, because of Jesus' sacrifice, you have a blood-bought right to live life as the blessed man of Jeremiah 17 and Psalm 1. Choose therefore to be the blessed man or woman.

Begin to enjoy good success in every area of your life by putting your trust and hope in Jesus alone. And the way you do that practically is to delight in and meditate day and night on God's everlasting and unshakable Word.

God's Word is a guaranteed constant. It never fails, never changes and never fades away. It will always stand the test of time. Ungodly counsel, on the other hand, is as fickle as the changing wind.

Beloved, if you want to be the blessed man and en-

joy unceasing fruitfulness this year, put your trust wholeheartedly in the Lord by meditating day and night on His wonderful promises found in His Word!

Let's look at an account of someone in the Bible who prioritized meditating on God's Word. If there's one man in the Bible who was told specifically by God to meditate on His Word day and night, it was Joshua. Joshua had just taken over from Moses as leader of the Israelites. This young man had big sandals to fill. He had to lead some three million Israelites, who were in the habit of complaining and doubting God, into the promised land. He had cities to conquer and giants to kill. Without a doubt, Joshua needed all the help he could get from God, and God knew it.

God gave Joshua the secret to prospering in all that he did and having good success: Joshua 1:8 This Book of the Law [God's Word] shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.

This means that Joshua would see divine results each time he led the Israelites into battle. He would see good come out of all the projects that he undertook. That's unceasing fruitfulness! He would also be well provided for, well protected and remain hale and hearty in body.

Psalm 30:5 affirms, "His anger is but for a moment, His favor is for a lifetime." A year encompasses all seasons – summer, fall, winter, and spring. We need to be reminded that we are still living in the year of God's favor, even if we experience trials and temptations. Discovering the Path to the Good Life by Dr. Creflo A. Dollar

God has already prepared a good life for you to live, but you must discover the path to that good life and walk in it. Your steps are ordered by the Lord, and He knows how to keep you from falling. By staying in God's Word and speaking it in faith, you will keep yourself on the path to abundant living and experience the fullness of God's promises in your life.

1. The "good life" is available to every Believer:

There is a pre-planned path that God has prepared for you to live the good life, which includes health, wealth and total life prosperity (Psalm 16:11).

In God's presence is pleasure and fullness of joy. Getting in the Word is a vehicle for getting into God's presence. God knows what will please you and make you happy. God will reveal to you the path that you should take in life.

2. The Word of God leads you to the good life.

You must stay on the Word if you want to stay on the path to the good life. There is a path that *seems* right and *looks* straight but will lead to destruction and disappointment (Proverbs 14:12). The path that leads to death is the one that the world encourages you to take. Listening to the words of the world's system and your own reasoning will take you down the wrong path.

3. The good life includes soteria, or wholeness and well-being in every area of your life.

God has bestowed His goodness on you through Jesus (Ephesians 2:6-10). You didn't earn salvation; you didn't deserve it, but He made it available anyway. You are a partaker of salvation through your faith. 'Salvation' is more than being born again.

It includes healing, deliverance, soundness, prosperity, protection and safety. Take authority over your situations and circumstances and refuse to accept a life that doesn't line up with God's Word.

There are good things that God has prepared for you that will be revealed as you follow His path. When you begin to see the manifestation of God's goodness in your life, don't forget that it came from Him (Deuteronomy 6:10-11).

4. You must allow the Holy Spirit to guide you on the path to the good life (Psalm 25:4).

* When your footsteps are established and guided by God, you will not slip (Psalm 17:5, 6; Psalm 37:23-25).


* Speaking God's Word will help protect you from the enemy (Psalm 17:4).


