### A Real Relationship with God - Joyce Meyer

When you think of religion, what comes to your mind—a set of rules, regulations and obligations or a deep, intimate relationship with God?

Having a relationship with God is about fellowship...not feeling like you have to struggle and strain to live right and be accepted by Him. That's religion. Through Jesus Christ, God extends a warm invitation to be in relationship with Him. This series will help you learn how to relax and enjoy a life of fellowship with the Father like never before. I like to consider myself someone who has a personal relationship with God through Jesus Christ. I believe He died so we could have a living, vital relationship with God, not just a bunch of rules and regulations we're forced to follow.

Yes, there are certain guidelines God wants us to follow, but His purpose in giving them is to protect us from the consequences of sin. When we have a real relationship with God through Christ, life gets exciting because He stirs up a passion inside us to love people—and we don't have to struggle to do the things He calls us to do. It just happens naturally.

The greatest thing God wants to hear from us is, "I love You, Lord. Thank You for everything You've done in my life. Many of us don't pray and ask God for what we need because we don't think we have a right to ask. But the Bible says God wants us to learn how to receive His mercy. Hebrews 4:15 says we have a High Priest, a perfect Savior, who understands our weaknesses. He's been tempted just like we are, yet He never sinned. Verse 16 says we can come fearlessly and confidently before God in prayer to receive His mercy and be forgiven.

**New Creature, New Features:** "Legally" you become a Child of God when you make the decision to receive Jesus Christ as your Savior. And after you receive Him, God begins to change you into a brand-new creation. We shouldn't be making up religious rules to live by, like having to read our Bible every single day; nor should we do whatever we want to because we know we're going to heaven when we die.

Christianity is about living a vibrant, exciting life in Christ, and it goes hand in hand with developing a personal relationship with Him. Jesus wants us to be in love with Him.



# Disunity

There's an unseen factor in Church's growth that most people overlook – church unity. God blesses a unified church. Many churches have tremendous potential, but they never achieve what God desires because the members spend all their time fighting with one another. All of the energy is focused inward.

The Bible talks more about unity of the church than it does about either heaven or hell. It's that important. Churches are made up of people, and there are no perfect people. So people get into conflict with each other. As pastors' elders and deacons, we need to learn how to deal with those situations. Specifically, we're called

to do these six things when disunity threatens our church.

1. **Avoid situations that cause arguments** 2 Timothy 2:23-24
2. **Teach troublemakers to repent** 2 Timothy 2:25-26
3. **Warn those causing trouble that their negative words hurt others.** 2 Timothy 2:14
4. **Make a plea for harmony and unity.** Philippians 4:2
5. **Rebuke with authority if necessary** Titus 2:15-3:1
6. **Remove them from the church if they ignore two warnings.** Titus 3:10-11

The Bible teaches that as the church grows, Satan will do every-

thing he can to cause division. Even well meaning people, even believers, can be used as tools of Satan to hurt the body of Christ. As pastors, as shepherds of God's people, it's our job to protect our congregations from *Satan's greatest weapon – disunity*. It's not always easy, but it's what we've been called to do.



May the God who gives endurance and encouragement give you a spirit of unity among yourselves as you follow Christ Jesus, - ROMANS 15:5 NIV

1 Corinthians 2:2 for I determined not to know anything among you except Jesus Christ and Him crucified.

The apostle Paul, in his letter to the Corinthian church, said that he determined to know nothing

among them except “Jesus Christ and Him crucified”. In other words, Paul had his mind full of Jesus and His finished work.

God wants your mind full of the cross of Jesus. He wants you cross-conscious. But what does it mean to be cross-conscious?

To be cross-conscious is to see Jesus, who loves you so much

that He willingly died for you on the cross. To be cross-conscious is to look to Jesus, who offered His own body to be punished, so that your body can be free from all punishment.

To be cross-conscious is to fix your eyes on Jesus, who has provided for your deliverance and victory at the cross. At the cross, all your enemies were vanquished. All your diseases were destroyed. Your poverty was removed at the cross. Your sins were wiped out at the cross.

When the Israelites tasted bitterness in the waters of Marah, God showed Moses a tree, which he cast into the waters, making them sweet. (Exodus 15:23–26) The tree represents the cross, which turned the bitter waters sweet. Today, Calvary's tree has turned your bitter

situations sweet. Because of the cross, you can expect to see the bitter situations in your life made sweet!

When the Israelites were bitten by serpents in the wilderness, God told Moses to put a bronze serpent on a pole. The pole represents the cross and bronze speaks of judgment. Those who beheld the serpent on the pole lived because they saw their problem — the deadly serpent — nailed and put to death on the cross. (Numbers 21:6–9)

Today, you too will not die but live when you see all your sins judged at the cross, and with them, all your sicknesses, diseases, pains, failures and defeats! At the cross, all that is deadly in your life has been removed!

God is in the process of bringing about transformation in the lives of all of His children. Each of us including others around you are experiencing change—maybe in ways where we cannot imagine a good outcome. Philippians 2:4: “Each of you should look not only to your own interest, but also to the interests of others.” We can look at others as people who may be undergoing change because of Jesus. We don’t need to know what that change is necessarily to encourage them.

We are called to transform living. Ephesians 4:30 reminds us that God himself is present in our life. When we fail to live transformed lives, we not only hurt ourselves, but also those around us and even grieve the heart of God. God made us for a purpose because God doesn’t make anything without a purpose. God wants you to use them for the purpose, which designed them for.

Zacchaeus lived a less than satisfactory life for many years. He was looking for a change (discovering level) when he met Jesus one day. On that day Zacchaeus was not just changed. His whole life was transformed. Today Jesus doesn’t want to change your life. *He wants to transform your life forever and you will never be the same.* This transformation will make you victorious over your situations.

*“To lead people to a transforming relationship with Jesus and to follow him in transforming the world.”*

1. **Surrender:** A transformed life is marked by willing surrender. Zacchaeus surrender His life (everything) to Jesus. Mind-Heart-body/life styles...are we today ready to surrender everything to Jesus?

2. **Renewal:** means renew your thinking. Zacchaeus did not invite Jesus into his home. This transforming life is not about those in need asking for help. It is about Jesus inviting himself into lives that need transforming.

Jesus came to His life/His house...transformed his living (renewal). If today we believe and receive Jesus as savior in our life, will transform life for His glory. Many guest/important persons visited the house of Zacchaeus and had fellowship, spent time, could not bring renewal thinking. But JESUS changes His life. Revelation 3:20 says....

Look at Zacchaeus’ response to their discussion, “Look, Lord, here and now I give half of my possessions to the poor. If I have cheated anybody out of anything, I will pay back four times the amount”. To his delight, Jesus responded by saying, “Today, salvation has come to this house, because this man, too, is a son of Abraham. For the Son of Man came to seek and save what was lost.”


When Jesus comes to your life...He will transform your life, renew your life style, when you surrender to Him could see God’ super natural things happening in your life. Zacchaeus had money, possession, authority but no hope/eternity. Jesus said ‘for now this house is saved’

*Jesus had never met Zacchaeus but he called him by his name.* You may not know Jesus, but he knew you even before you were conceived in your mother’s womb. You are not here today because you came in search of Him. But he came in search of you. God transforms a life through redemption act in Jesus Christ on the cross of Calvary. Romans chapter 12 brings a picture of a life transformed by God. Zacchaeus paid back four times the amount to every person that he had cheated and gave half of his possessions to the poor *as a sign of repentance.*

Today the church use water baptism as a sign of repentance. Are you ready to believe, obey, repent and be baptized? The bible says, “Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.” Mark 16:16 ...Are You Read?
